In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to Article 309 of Constitution of India, the Governor of Karnataka here by makes the following rules, namely:-

1. TITLE, COMMENCEMENT AND APPLICATION -

- (1) These Rules may be called the Karnataka Civil Services (Automatic grant of Special Promotion to Senior Scale of pay) Rules, 1991.
 - (2) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the first day of June, 1991.
- (3) These rules shall apply to all the Government Servants holding the category of posts carrying the scales of pay specified in column (2) of the table below or the selection time scale of pay granted under the Karnataka Civil Services (Time Bound Advancement) Rules, 1991 Specified in column 3 thereof, namely:-

- (4) these rules shall not apply to -
- (a) Person borne on work-charged establishments, with no lien on any post in regular establishments of Civil Services, unless otherwise provided by an order issued by the Government. :
- (b) Persons paid out of contingencies, unless otherwise provided by an order issued by the Government.
- (c) Persons paid hourly, daily, weekily or monthly rates, wages;
- (d) Persons not in whole-time employment;
- (e) Persons paid only on a piece-rate basis:
- (f) Persons employed on consolidated pay or salary:
- (g) Persons appointed on consolidated pay or salary;
- (h) Persons re-employed in Government service after retirement;
- (i) Persons who have vlountarily foregone their promotion;
- (j) Persons drawing pay in the UGC/AICTE scale of pay;
- (k) Persons borne on the All India Services working under the Government; and
- (I) Any other class or category of persons whom the Government may, by order, specifically exclude from the operation of all or any of the provisions of these rules.
- 2. DEFINITION: In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
- (1) 'Appointing authority' in relation to a Government servant means :-
- (a) the authority empowered to make appointment to the services of which the Government servant is for the time being a member or to the grade of the service in which the Government servant is for the time being included: or
- (b) the authority empowered to make appointments to the post in which Government servant for the time being holds: or
